Forest Ridge Homeowners,

Please remember, if you are discharging fireworks within city limits you must have a permit and follow the City Ordinance regulations (*found on brokenarrowok.gov*). As much as we all love watching and lighting fireworks, we also need to remember to respect our fellow neighbors.

Below you will find a few key points to remember from the City of Broken Arrow:

- Permits are valid during the hours of 3-11 p.m. on July 3-4 only.
- Fireworks debris must be extinguished and disposed of properly, by placing inside trash bags. Large boxes may be placed next to trash bags. Failure to do so may result in fines of \$225.00 plus cost.
- Fireworks must be discharged on a noncombustible surface of sufficient size to contain the entire ground portion of the display, not closer than 25 feet to any permanent structure.

We encourage you to call the Broken Arrow Police Department at 918-259-8400 to report anyone who discharges fireworks outside of the set times allowed. **If you need to report firework debris, please call the Action Center at 918-258-3587.**

SIGN ORDINANCE

The Forest Ridge Board of Directors is in progress of approving to adopt the Code of Ordinance for Broken Arrow, under Chapter 5, Section 5.7, 9. (h). states: Temporary election signs dealing with political campaigning, if erected not more than 45 days prior to an election and removed within seven days following the election and does not exceed 16 square feet of display surface area.

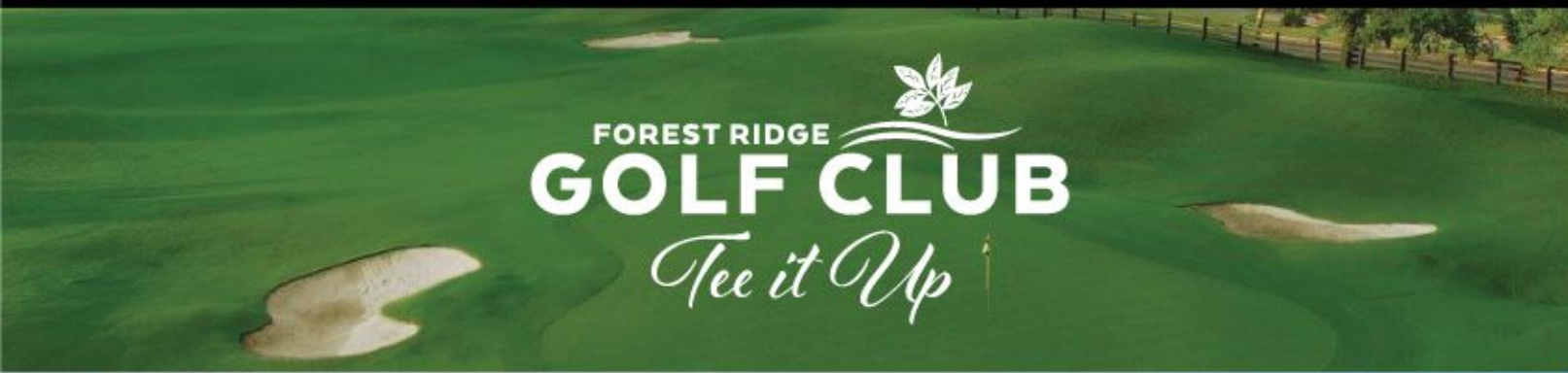
The Forest Ridge WGA had their monthly tournament on June 25 and played the point system called Stableford Tournament. The winners were:

SOUTHERN COFFEE

Punch Recipe

Are you still wanting to drink your daily cup of Joe, but this hot weather has you thinking twice? Don't worry, I found a great solution – Coffee Punch! It's the perfect blend of coffee and ice cream, and if you serve it to your guests, you'll quickly become the talk of the town (or Forest Ridge Community).

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 cups boiling water
- 1 gallon 2% milk
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1 gallon vanilla ice cream
- 1 (2 oz. jar) instant coffee granules (such as Nescafe)

DIRECTIONS:

1. Stir boiling water, sugar, and instant coffee together in a bowl until dissolved; cool in refrigerator, 30 minutes to overnight.
2. Pour coffee mixture into a punch bowl; add milk and vanilla ice cream. Stir until ice cream begins to melt.
